Important Dates

- Online registration must be completed by October 20th, 2017
- A tentative schedule will be posted by November 3rd and a final schedule by Monday, November 27th
- All shirt pre-orders must be received by November 15th

Divisions for Competition

- 5A Cheer, 5A Pom, Coed, 4A Cheer, 4A Pom, All Classification Hip Hop and Jazz, Freshman Cheer, Freshman Pom
- Divisions may be combined based on teams registered. If you would like to compete in a higher division please let us know when you register.

General Schedule (day of the event)

- 7:00am Doors Open for Teams
- Team Registration – We will have two different registration sessions available during the day (where you submit completed waivers) followed by a coaches meeting. Each team must have one coach register their team and attend the coaches meeting. Please make sure your team is registered at least one hour prior to their warm-up time. Times will be noted in the schedule.
- 8am Doors Open for Spectators
- 8am Coaches Meeting
- 8:20am Report Time Begins (report to warm-up ½ hour prior to your performance time, be on time for warm-ups and come ready to compete)
- 8:30am Judges Meeting
- 8:55am National Anthem
- 9am Competition Begins
- 4:00pm Awards (approximately)
- Please be flexible with the schedule. It is our intent to run a smooth and efficient competition.
- Your understanding is greatly appreciated. Please communicate this to your fans and supporters. All changes will be posted on our website

Team Entry Fee

- \$100 per team (Non-refundable)
- Deadline: Friday, October 20th
- Please register online through CSCA website
- Rescheduling the event is not an option. Entry fees will not be refunded. If poor weather occurs we may delay the start of the event.
- Coaches' passes will be provided for up to two coaches. Additional passes are \$10 each and can be purchased the day of the event.

- Location: The Denver Coliseum
- I-70 from either direction to Brighton Boulevard exit, South ½ mile Coliseum is on the right
- Parking is available and run by the City of Denver. Previous years the cost has been \$10

Coaches Checklist:

- Waiver for all participants (medical information must be complete), teams with incomplete waivers will not be able to compete
- Music on CD and/or iPod/Phone, and several backups (iPod or phone on airplane mode preferred)
- Specific items for your team such as signs, etc.
- Medical needs, trainer will be on site but you must provide your own athletic tape
- Order forms for team pictures or event t-shirts! No professional videotaping will be offered at this event.

Rules & Results:

- The 2017-2018 National Federation of State High School Associations Spirit Rules book will be followed.
- The 2017 CHSAA Spirit Bulletin will be followed (<http://www2.chsaa.org/sports/spirit/>)
There have been rule and score sheet changes this year. Make sure you read over the entire bulletin for these changes. No video reviews.
- No Varsity team member may compete in the JV Invitational. If a participant has competed, or will compete, for the 2017-2018 season as a varsity team member, they may not compete at the JV Invitational. If you are not sure please contact us.
- Penalty review will take place at the conclusion of each preliminary round after scores have been tabulated. Reviews will take place in the warm-up gym. The time of each review will be noted on the schedule but please listen for the exact time once each division has finished. If you miss the review we will not come looking for you.
- Scores and recap sheets will be available after finalists are announced or after awards have been given. If your team does not make finals, recap sheets will be available outside the coaches' lounge. If your team makes finals, recaps will be given during awards in front of trophy table. A brief summary of scores will be posted in the lounge area. Recaps not picked up will be mailed but we encourage you to pick-up your recaps before you leave the school.
- The number of placements to be awarded in each division will be determined once we see total number of teams registered.
- All awards will take place after the 5A cheer & pom finals. Overall rankings will be posted at the event after finalists are announced and at the conclusion of the event after awards.
- *****Parents and fans react to the results the way that you respond or coach them to respond. In a smaller venue, every reaction is even more obvious. Tech judges are available to answer coaches' questions but none of the staff will discuss results with parents. Your professionalism at this event is appreciated.**

Advancement to Finals:

- Advancement to finals is based on the number of teams that compete in each discipline (just like CHSAA).
In each discipline, the following advance to finals:
 - 39 or more teams competing – top 8 advance
 - 26-38 teams competing – top 6 advance
 - 13-25 teams competing – top 4 advance
 - 12 and under – top 2 advance
